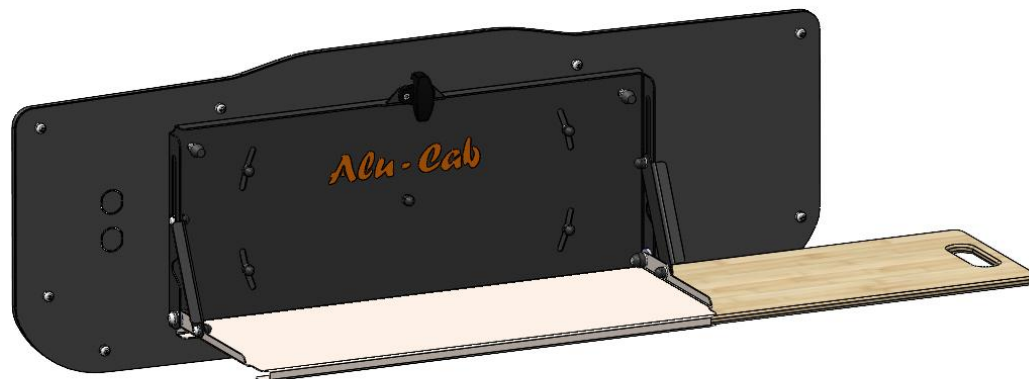

- 2.1 Remove large rear interior door panel



- 2.2 Drill out the door panel mounting holes to 9mm and fasten the M6 Riv-Nuts into the holes



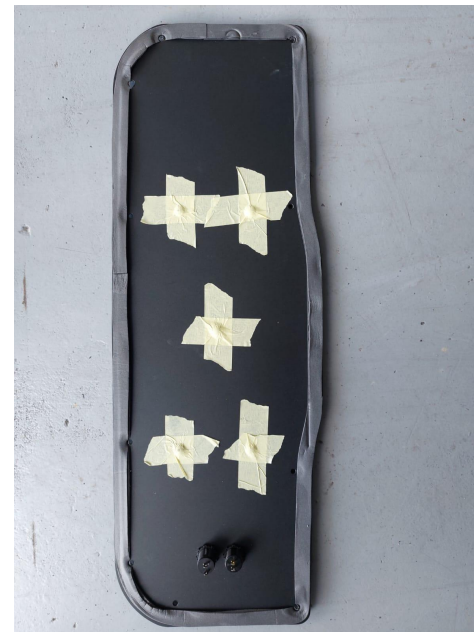
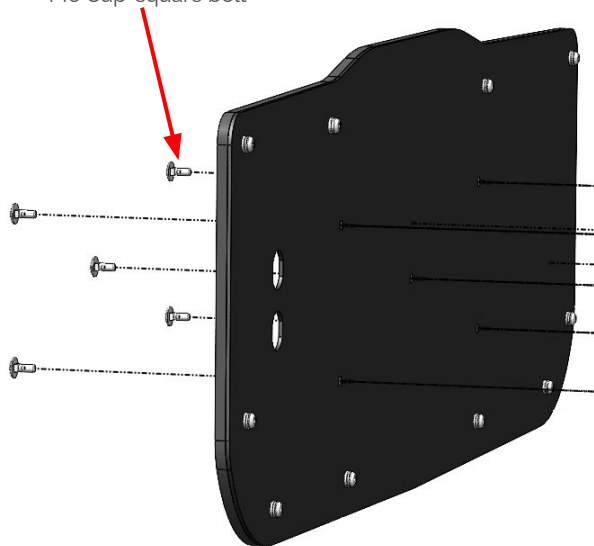

Push the M6 cupsquare bolts through the square hole in the mounting plate and secure the back of the the bolt to the mounting plate with strong bond tape to keep it in place.

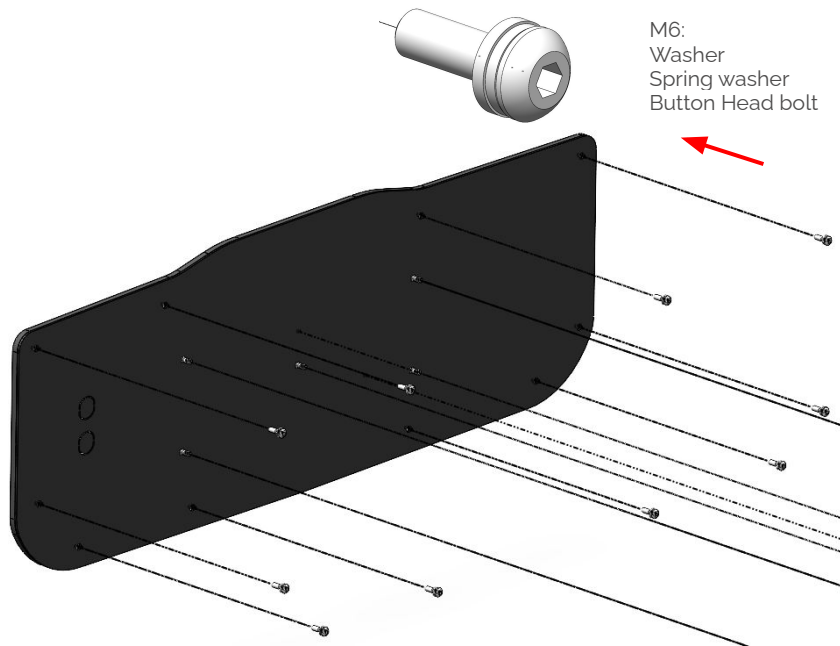
M6 Cup-square bolt

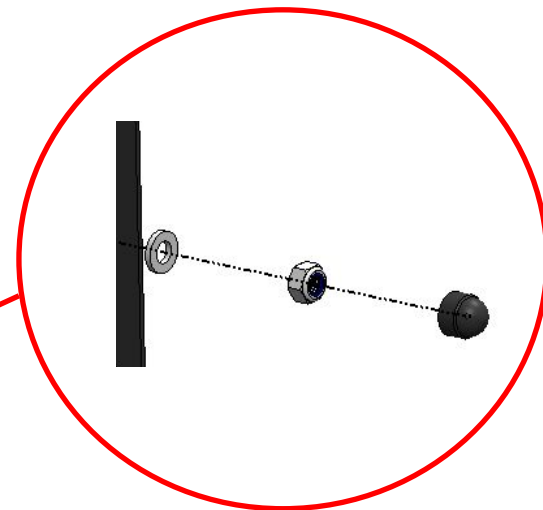
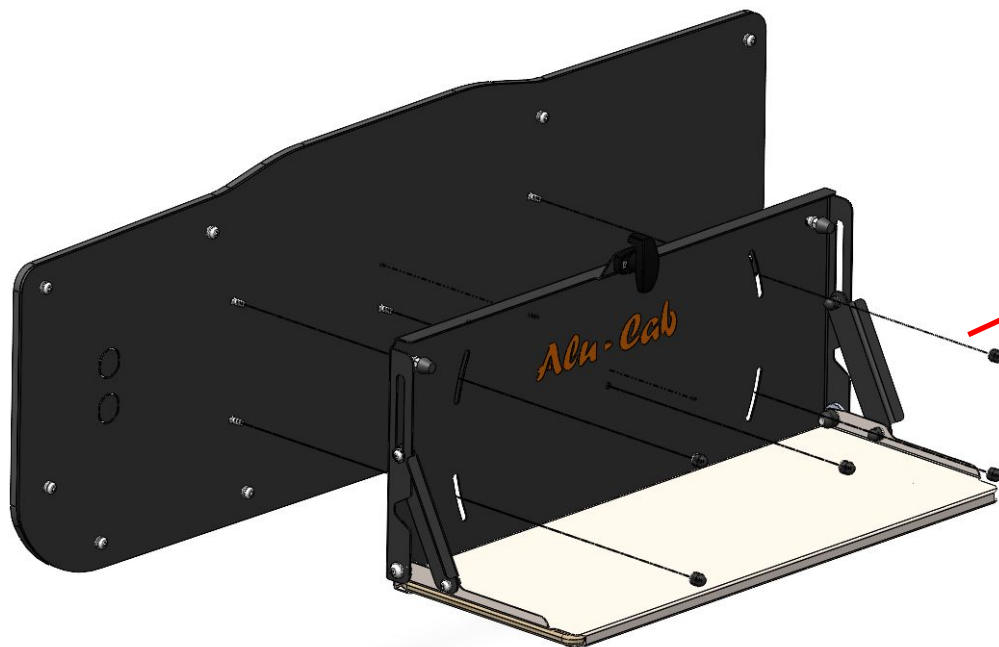

Lift the tent enough to place a bolt on either side of the load bar, front and rear. Position the tent into the correct place for your fitment.

- 5 Fasten the M6 nyloc nuts to the cupsquare bolts at your preferred table angle.
